

WRP 2008 Wetlands Symposium Wetland Photo Exhibit and Contest



The photo exhibit and contest entry guidelines are:

1. The photograph must be of a southern California river, coastal stream, vernal pool, or estuarine wetland within the WRP's region: Point Conception in Santa Barbara County to the Mexican border.
2. The entry is by an electronic file only -- no slides, prints, film or other photographic media will be accepted. Entry must be sent by e-mail or by USB flash drive in standard mail.
3. The image's resolution and size must be no less than 300 pixels per inch (ppi) and 2400 pixels x 3600 pixels. Image format must be high quality (low compression) JPEG.
4. Only one image per entry to the photo contest; multiple images allowed for entry to the exhibit (if you enter multiple photos, please designate which you want considered for the contest; no more than 5 total images per person.)
5. The image included in the entry must be the original work of the contestant. The entry must be the work of a sole individual. No compensation is given for entry or selection. Entry to this contest allows WRP to reproduce the images in any of its promotional pieces (electronic, print, etc.) with credit given to the photographer.
6. An acceptable entry includes the image and a fully completed electronic [photo contest submission form](#), which are e-mailed to the WRP at skelly@scwrp.org. You can also use the site www.yousendit.com to transmit the image. Alternate means of entry is an electronic file of the image together with the electronic photo contest submission form copied to a USB flash drive and mailed to the following address:

Email is preferred to reduce our carbon footprint. If you mail your submission on a flash drive, please include a self addressed and stamped return envelope to facilitate returning the flash drive to the sender.

7. The deadline for submission is April 30 (must be received by this date). Your entry will be displayed digitally at the WRP 10-year Anniversary event at the WRP Symposium on May 7.
